The new ADAI Clearinghouse opens Tuesday, **September 6!**

The Washington State Alcohol/Drug Clearinghouse closed on June 30, 2011, due to cuts in the state budget. But with help from NW HIDTA and the Alcohol and Drug Institute at the University of Washington, a new alcohol and drug Clearinghouse is opening to serve residents of the state of Washington.

The ADAI Clearinghouse will provide the latest information on substance abuse prevention and treatment, as well as materials in related fields such as mental health and public health. The public can browse and pick up free resources in person, and as before, community organizations are welcome to contact the Clearinghouse to request bulk quantities of materials – available at no charge except the cost of shipping. The Clearinghouse will be exhibiting materials at upcoming trainings and community events, beginning this week at the 3 Faces of Healing conference.

The Clearinghouse website (<http://adaiclearinghouse.org>) is under construction, but soon you will be able to use an online catalog to search for and order print materials or download electronic documents. We also have a library of 200+ videos and DVDs. You'll find helpful links to alcohol and drug abuse organizations in Washington and the nation.

To keep the Washington state prevention community up to date about news, resources, and events of interest, we're also introducing **ADAI eNews**, an email newsletter.
